Dear Secretary Cole:

We serve as the president and chairperson, respectively, of the Village of Random Lake and the Town of Sherman, in southern Sheboygan County. We have recently become aware of plans by Country Visions Cooperative of Reedsville to make changes to their facility in the Town of Sherman, on property immediately adjacent to the Village of Random Lake. Residents of our communities have expressed concerns about possible adverse environmental impacts from these changes.

Of particular concern is any possible increase in particulate matter or fugitive dust emissions in an area very close to Random Lake, a lake covering approximately 209 acres entirely within the Village of Random Lake, and also close to existing housing and to land designated for housing in the Village's 20-Year Comprehensive Plan. The site of the proposed project is a parcel that includes wetlands and is bounded in part by a stream that flows into Random Lake.

We are asking that the Department of Natural Resources carefully review construction and operation permit requirements related to this project. Those bringing their concerns to us have shared that they believe there should be no permitting exemptions related to either NR 406.04 Direct Source Exempt from Construction Permit Requirements or NR 407.03, Exemptions from Operation Permit Requirements.

We are also asking that the Department work to ensure compliance with all provisions of Chapter NR 415, Control of Particulate Emissions and Chapter NR 431, Control of Visible Emissions, and any other applicable standards pertaining to emissions from an agricultural processing facility.

It is our understanding that because of the commercial nature of this project it is not likely to require any action by either the Town of Sherman or the Village of Random Lake.

Sec. 30-5, -Snow and Ice Removal

- (a) **Sidewalks to be kept clear**. The owner, occupant or person in charge of each and every building or structure or unoccupied lot in the Village fronting or abutting any street shall clean, or cause to be cleaned, the sidewalk in front of or adjoining each such building or unoccupied lot of snow or ice to the width of such sidewalk within 24 hours after the cessation of a snowstorm. When the ice has formed on any sidewalk so that it cannot be immediately removed, the persons herein referred to shall keep the same area treated with salt, ashes, sawdust, cat litter or other sand.
- (b) **Deposits in street prohibited**. No person shall deposit, or cause to be deposited, any snow or ice taken and removed from his or her premises or elsewhere upon any sidewalk, alley, parkway, public place or street in the Village. Snow shall not be piled at or near intersections so as to obstruct the view of pedestrians or operators of motor vehicles.
- (c) Removal by Village. Deposit of any snow or ice upon any sidewalk, alley or street of the Village contrary to the provisions of this section shall be and is declared to be a nuisance and, in addition to the penalty provided for violation of this section, the Village may summarily remove any snow or ice that has been deposited and cause the cost of said removal to be charged to the owner of the property from which said snow or ice has been removed. If not paid within 30 days, such charge shall be extended upon the current or next tax roll as a charge for the current services, as provided in Wis. Stats. §§ 66.0703

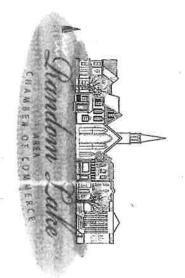

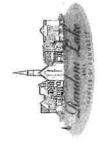
