Dear Board Members:

Bids were received from three (3) Contractors to complete the Wastewater Treatment Facility Upgrades project as detailed in the plans and specifications prepared by our office. Below is a breakdown of the results:

	Engineer Estimate	Staab Construction Corp.	C.D.Smith Construction	J.H.Hassinger Inc.
Bid Total:	\$7,689,183	\$14,883,000	\$15,716,165	\$16,505,785

Bids can be held for 90 days before acting on them. At this time, it is recommended to not act on the bids until more information can be gathered and presented to the Village Board.

The design team is currently gathering information to provide guidance with options on how to proceed. These include:

- The team met with the low bidder on Wednesday January 11 to get a better understanding of the prices that were submitted and current bidding climate in Wisconsin and other states for treatment plant projects
- The team has a meeting scheduled for Friday January 13 with WDNR regulators to discuss the current bids and potential design alternatives
- The team has reached out to WDNR Clean Water Fund administrators to discuss further options
- The team spoke with the Rural Development Program of USDA for funding considerations
- The team is coordinating with Ehlers on financing

The design team will meet with President Mr. San Felippo and DPW Mr. Lederer to discuss options in the next two weeks. A formal presentation will then be given to the Village Board on Monday February 6.

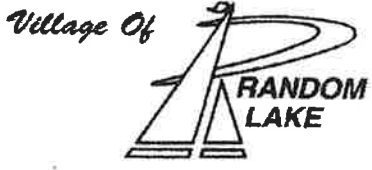

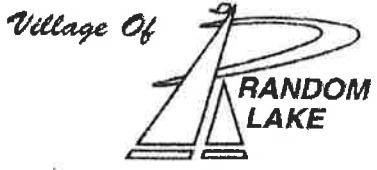
