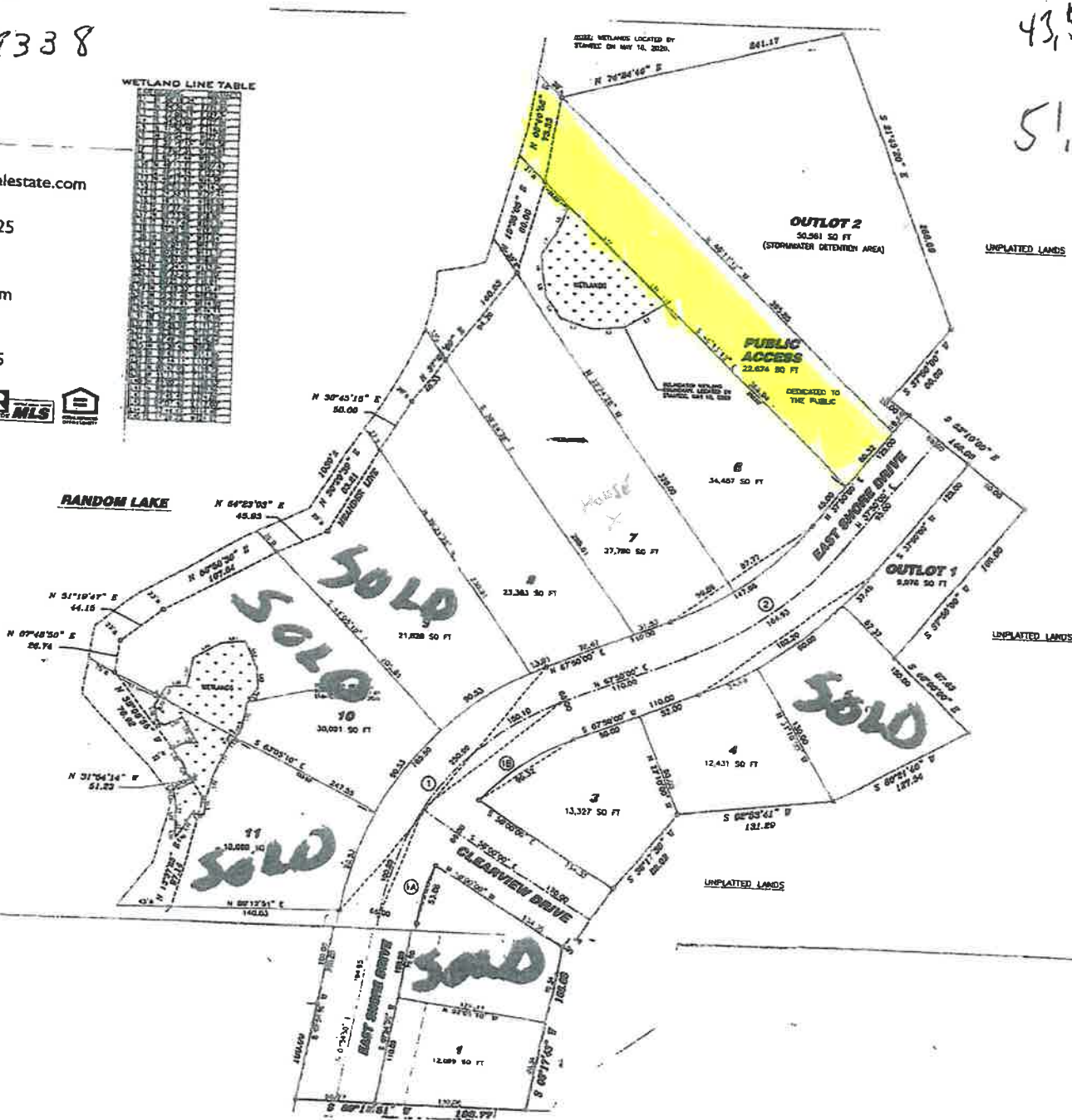

RE: Plat Review for Lake View Estates in the Village of Random Lake

Dear Mr. Prudlow:

This letter is being sent in response to our phone conversation on April 29, 2002 regarding the waiver of the public access platting requirement for your development on Random Lake in Sheboygan County.

Public access requirements for subdivisions adjacent to navigable waters are specified in s. 236.16(3), Wis. Stats., which states all subdivisions abutting on a navigable lake or stream shall provide public access at least 60 feet wide. By reserving public access on a waterbody at half-mile intervals along the shore, the public can use, recreate, and enjoy waters of the state. Please note that there is no requirement for this public right-of-way to be improved with a boat launch or designated parking. The statute only requires that a 60-foot wide strip of land be platted to ensure public access to Random Lake.

The Department strongly supports the concept of providing public access to waters of the state and would not be in favor of waiving this requirement for your proposed development.

You have submitted the preliminary plat of LAKE VIEW ESTATES for review. The Department of Administration does not object to this preliminary plat and certifies it as complying with the requirements of: s. 236.16, and s. 236.20 Wis. Stats.; and ch. Trans 233, Wis. Admin. Code.; and the Sheboygan County Planning & Resources Department.

DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION COMMENTS:

We have examined and find that, with the exceptions noted below, this preliminary plat appears to conform with the applicable layout requirements of ss. 236.16 and 236.20, Wis. Stats.

- s. 236.16 (2) The overall width of streets in the plat scale and are assumed to be 66' wide.
- s. 236.16 (3) This section provides that for all plats abutting a navigable lake or stream, there be at least 60' of public access at not more than one-half mile intervals as measured along the shoreline except where greater intervals and wider access is agreed upon by the Department of Natural Resources and this agency.

If there is an existing public access to RANDOM LAKE within one-half mile of this subdivision, it must be identified on the final plat by noting the width of the access and the pertinent shoreline measurements to the access.

If there is not an existing public access meeting the requirements of this section, a 60' wide public access to RANDOM LAKE is required on this plat or a public access waiver must be requested.

- s. 236.16 (4) If the subdivider has any interest in the unplatted lands lying between lots 6 and 7 and the outlot of this plat and the water's edge of RANDOM LAKE and if such lands are for any reason unplattable, they must be included in the subject plat as part of the lots, outlots or public dedications. Otherwise, these lands must be marked "plattable lands" or "owned by others".
- s. 236.20 (2) (e) On the final plat, the outlot must be numbered, and the parcel labeled "temporary turnaround easement" must be shown as a consecutively numbered lot or outlot.
- s. 236.20 (3) (a) Records of the original land surveys show the southeast quarter of section 26 to be divided into government lots. Quarter-quarter references are not appropriate. Therefore, on the final plat, the description under the plat name and when referenced in any certificates must be changed to: "Part of Government Lot 4, section 26, T13N..."
- s. 236.20 (5) (c) On the final plat, complete water elevations, including high, low, and elevation on the date of survey, must be shown for RANDOM LAKE and referenced to a permanent established datum plane.

NOTES FOR THE FINAL PLAT:

- The platted status of the lands northwest and northeast of the outlot must be shown, and underlined with dashed or dotted lines.
- The name of the street between lots 2 and 3 must be shown.
- The plat boundaries must be shown extended to the waters edge with a solid line. The meander line must be labeled as such.

NOTE TO CLERK: Either prior to or with the final plat submittal we must receive your certification regarding sewerage facilities. Our standard form is enclosed for your convenience.

DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION:

The Department of Transportation is an objecting agency on this plat. On February 12, 2002 we transmitted two copies to them for review. On February 22, 2002 we received a copy of the plat certifying no objection.

COUNTY PLANNING AGENCY:

The Sheboygan County Planning & Resources Department is an objecting agency on this plat. On February 12, 2002 we transmitted copies to them for review. On February 22, 2002 we received a copy of the plat certifying no objection.

Local government units, during their review of the plat, will resolve, when applicable, that the plat:

- complies with local comprehensive plans, official map or subdivision control ordinances;
- conforms with areawide water quality management plans, if sewerage;
- complies with Wisconsin shoreland management regulations;
- resolves possible problems with storm water runoff;
- fits the design to the topography;
- displays well designed lot and street layout;
- includes service or is serviceable by necessary utilities.

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE VILLAGE BOARD OF RANDOM LAKE,
WISCONSIN, IN REGULAR SESSION-OCTOBER 7, 2002**

Pres. called meeting to order at 7 P.M.

Roll Call: Present-Lenninger, Soerens, Schneider, Boerger, Siebenaler & McDermott. Stevens seated at 7:07 P.M. Also present-Francis Murphy, Richard Prudlow, Bill Goehring, Gary Feider and Dan Klotz.

Clerk/Treasurer read Planning Commission recommendation re: approval of final plat for Lakeview Estates Subdivision pending DNR approval of public access and stormwater retention area. Following discussion, motion Siebenaler; 2nd Boerger to approve final plat of Lakeview Estates Subdivision pending DNR approvals as recommended by Planning Commission. Carried.

Kathy Kramaz of DNR updated those present on Davis' stormwater retention area.

Board reviewed plat showing .12 acre needed for road in Woodlands of East Towne Subdivision. Darrell Davis & Roger Wagner are proposing to quit claim this .12 acre to the Village at this time. Once this quit claim is recorded, the balance of the road area will also be quit claimed. Motion Lenninger; 2nd Boerger to accept quit claim for .12 acre of road in Woodlands of East Towne Subdivision from Davis & Wagner. Carried.

Board reviewed WE Energies proposals for street lighting on east side of lake as follows: change/relocate/remove/install street lighting located at East Shore Drive and Evergreen Drive-\$840.00 and installation of 4 additional poles and lights-\$4023.19. Motion Lenninger; 2nd Siebenaler to approve both proposals as outlined above and to submit signed proposals and required payments totaling \$4863.19 to WE Energies. Carried.

Subcommittee on water and sewer met re: clean water entering sewer due to leaks and policy on payment for such. Committee recommended Board adopt the following policy: 1) To have request considered, usage for quarter must be 500% over average for last 4 quarters; 2) Request for consideration for reduction of sewer charge must be received in Village office within 30 days of receipt of bill; 3) Water must be paid for in full & 4) A note from a licensed plumber identifying the problem and stating it was repaired must accompany request for consideration. As part of the policy, committee recommended using formula proposed by Judy Gottlieb of DNR to calculate reduced sewer charge providing other items set forth above are met timely. Policy will be placed on agenda for action at 10-21-02 Village Board meeting.

Motion Boerger; 2nd Stevens to recalculate sewer charge on John Best's rental unit based on formula put forth by committee if policy is adopted at next meeting. Carried.

**PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING
MONDAY, OCTOBER 7, 2002**

The meeting was called to order at 6:33 P.M. by the Village President.

Roll Call: Present-Ken Borchardt, Dave Borchardt, Mueller, Lenninger, Schneider, Klotz & McDermott. Also present-Francis Murphy, Richard Prudlow, Wes Siebenaler & Gary Feider.

Richard Prudlow presented final plat for Lakeview Estates Subdivision to Planning Commission for their approval. Plat was distributed to Planning Commission members prior to this meeting for their review. Prudlow answered questions posed by members of the Planning Commission regarding the public access and whether or not people using the public access would be allowed to cross the wetlands on the parcel. Prudlow also explained that there would be one change on the final plat. The short stubbed street on the plat designated as Strigenz Drive would have its name changed to Clearview Drive as Dr. Strigenz did not wish a street named after him.

Motion Dave Borchardt; 2nd Klotz to recommend to the full Village Board approval of the final plat pending DNR approval of the public access and stormwater retention area. Carried.

Prudlow informed Planning Commission members that the plans should be done in the next day or so. He will bring these in to the Village office as soon as they are done. After Dan Klotz reviews them they will be presented to the Planning Commission for their review and approval. The covenants for the subdivision will be presented at a later date as the attorney is still working on them.

President requested two volunteers from the Planning Commission to act on the "Smart Growth" Committee with members from the Town of Sherman and the Village of Adell. One volunteer was needed as a permanent member and one was needed to act as an alternate. Dave Borchardt volunteered to serve on the committee as a permanent member and Ken Borchardt volunteered his service as an alternate.

Motion Dave Borchardt; 2nd Klotz to adjourn. Carried.

(e) A subdivision of any width for access to the water surface on the master plan or subdivision plan or a structure shall be given as that of the lotting subject if there is no master plan or subdivision plan or if the lotting subject is less than 60 feet wide, unless otherwise permitted by local ordinance. Widths of town roads platted after January 1, 1966, shall, however, comply with minimum standards for town roads prescribed by s. 82.50. Streets or frontage roads auxiliary to and located on the side of a full street for service to the abutting property may not after January 1, 1966, be less than 49.5 feet wide.

(3) LAKE AND NAVIGABLE STREAM SHORE PLATS; PUBLIC ACCESS

(a) All subdivisions abutting on a lake or a navigable stream shall provide public access at least 60 feet wide providing access to the water's edge so that there will be public access, which is connected to existing public roads, at not more than one-half mile intervals as measured along the lake or the navigable stream shore except where greater intervals and wider access is agreed upon by the department of natural resources and the department, and excluding shore areas where public parks or open-space streets or roads on either side of the navigable stream are provided.

(b) No public access established under this chapter may be vacated except by circuit court action as provided in s. 336.43, except that such public access may be discontinued under s. 66.1003, subject to s. 66.1006.

(c) Except as provided in par. (d), this subsection does not require any local unit of government to improve land provided for public access.

(d) All of the owners of all of the land adjacent to a public access established under par. (a) to an inland lake, as defined in s. 30.92(1)(bk), may petition the city, village, town or county that owns the public access to construct shoreline erosion control measures. Subject to par. (e), the city, village, town or county shall construct the requested shoreline erosion control measures or request the department of natural resources to determine the need for shoreline erosion control measures. Upon receipt of a request under this paragraph from a city, village, town or county, the department of natural resources shall follow the notice and hearing procedures in s. 30.208(3) to (5). Subject to par. (e), the city, village, town or county shall construct shoreline erosion control measures as required by the department of natural resources if the department of natural resources determines all of the following:

1. Erosion is evident along the shoreline in the vicinity of the public access.
2. The shoreline erosion control measures proposed by the owners of the property adjacent to the public access are designed according to accepted engineering practices.
3. Sufficient property owners, in addition to the owners of all property adjacent to the public access, have agreed to construct shoreline erosion control measures so that the shoreline erosion control project is likely to be effective in controlling erosion at the location of the public access and its vicinity.
4. The shoreline erosion control project is not likely to be effective in controlling erosion at the location of the public access and its vicinity if the city, village, town or county does not construct shoreline erosion control measures on the land provided for public access.

(e) A city, village, town or county may not be required to construct shoreline erosion control measures under par. (d) on land other than land provided for public access.

(f) Paragraphs (b) to (e) apply to public access that exists on, or that is established after, May 7, 1998.

When a strip of land was labeled on a plat "Public Access" that abutted a lake and connected to a public highway, the plat substantially met the statutory requirement of a "clear dedication to the public." While the dedication did not contain the exact formula found in sub. (3), under *Horn*, 18 Wis. 2d 113 (1965), that is not necessary. *Vande Zande v. Town of Marquette*, 2008 WI App 144, 314 Wis. 2d 145, 158 NW2d 18, 07-2354.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-04

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTIONS 8-131(b), 8-131(c)(9), 8-133(b)(1); 8-133(b)(8); 8-133(b)(10-11), 8-133(c), 8-138(b)(2), RELATED TO LICENSING OF SHORT-TERM RENTALS IN THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF RANDOM LAKE, SHEBOYGAN COUNTY, WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, the Village of Random Lake adopted the Licensing of Short Term Rentals Code of Ordinances on March 5, 2018, followed by several amendments that have been enacted, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Random Lake believes it is in the best interest of the Village to regulate short-term rentals under Wisconsin Statutes Section 66.0615(1)(dk); and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Random Lake to require all properties advertising as short-term rentals be licensed and inspected; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Random Lake, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 8-131(b) Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

(b) Each short-term rental is required to have the following licenses and permits:

~~(1) A license from the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection~~

(1) A license from the State of Wisconsin License for a Tourist Rooming House or a current Sheboygan County Health Department License

(2) A seller's permit issued by the Wisconsin Department of Revenue

~~(3) A room tax permit required by local, county and/or state government.~~

(3) A license from the village clerk

SECTION 2: Section 8-131(c)(9) Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

(9) All rental of the short-term rental shall be subject to payment of any ~~county~~ applicable sales tax in place and at the current applicable rate. ~~Permit holders are responsible for complying with all regulations of the room tax.~~

Items 10-17 will move up numerically to now be 9-16.

SECTION 3: Section 8-133(b)(1); Section 8-133(b)(8); Section 8-133(b)(10-11) Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

- (1) A copy of the State of Wisconsin License for a Tourist Rooming House License issued under Wis Stat 254.64 or a current Sheboygan County Health Department License.
- (8) Designation of property manager; if applicable
- ~~(10) A room tax permit issued by local, county and/or county entity where applicable.~~
- (10) An employer identification number issued by the Internal Revenue Service.
- ~~(11) An employer identification number issued by the Internal Revenue Service.~~

SECTION 4: Section 8-133(c) Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

(c) *Terms and filing date.* Each permit and license shall run ~~during a calendar year~~ from July 1st to June 30th. The filing fee shall be paid upon filing of the application. The clerk may conditionally accept late applications, subject to payment of the late filing fee. Any application which does not include all of the information and documentation shall be considered as incomplete.

SECTION 5: Section 8-138(b)(2) Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed as follows:

~~(2) Failure to make payment on the Sheboygan County room tax, if required.~~

Items 3-7 will move up numerically to now be 2-6.

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take affect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
