Park & Lake Information

When attendants are on duty, parking at Lakeview Park is \$5 per vehicle, unless you provide a driver's license, auto registration, or utility bill showing an address within village boundaries.

All boats (including lakefront property owners) are subject to launch fees.

Beach Regulations:

- Grilling, barbecuing or otherwise cooking food with gas, wood, charcoal or any other heating source is prohibited on the beach.
- * Smoking of all kinds, including but not limited to, cigarettes, electronic cigarettes, vapor cigarettes, and all other tobacco products are prohibited on the beach.
- * Dogs are not allowed on the beach or in the swim area.

Season Boat Launch Passes

• Resident: \$50.00 per vessel, Non-Resident: \$75.00 per vessel

2020 season boat launch passes for Lakeview Park are now available at the Village office during regular business hours. Each boat/watercraft requires its own pass.

Lake property owners—if the boat/watercraft stays on the lake all summer the launch fee is \$5.00. If it's used on other lakes, you may want to consider purchasing a season pass.

Short-Term Rentals (30 days or less)

If you plan to rent your property during the calendar year 2020, the property **must** be licensed with the Village. Applications and requirements are available in the Village office.

Village Reminders:

- Building permits are required for new home construction, roofing projects, siding, and certain remodeling projects. If you have questions on whether or not you need a permit, please feel free to call the Village office.
- Yard Maintenance: All lawns in the Village must be maintained at a height no greater than 6 inches. Vacant lots must also be kept cut to prevent weeds from spreading to neighboring properties. Please remember lawn cutting debris is not to be blown onto the street or sidewalks per Village ordinance.

2020 Election Dates:

General Election — November 3, 2020

We are excited to announce a direct payment option for utility payments.

Residents can sign up by filling out the information on the form included in this utility billing. How direct payment works, is that between the 10th-15th of the due date month (January, April, July, and October) the amount due will be directly debited from your bank account. You will still receive quarterly bills to let you know the amount that will be withdrawn from your account.

<u>Deduct Meters:</u> Please phone in your meter readings by the 1st of March, June, September & December. Failure to call in could result in a loss of deduction. We are unable to give residents a negative bill.

Deferred Payment Arrangements:

If you are unable to pay the full amount of your bill please contact the Village office for payment options.

- PET LICENSING: Cat & Dog licenses were due by April 1st to avoid a late charge of \$10.00 per animal. Licenses are available at the village office. The cost for 2020 with the \$10 late fee is now: \$16.00 if the animal is spayed/neutered or \$23.00 if they are not.
- ◆ **Dog Leash Reminder:** It is unlawful for any person owning or possessing any dog or cat to permit it to run at-large. A dog is considered to be running atlarge if it is off the premises of its owner and not under the control of the owner or some other person. The possibility of maintaining control of the animal by using voice commands is prohibited means of control and does not prevent the animal from being atlarge. Retractable leashes that have the capability of extending beyond six feet, but that may be retracted to within six feet are not in compliance with this provision.
