GOLF CARTS:

The Village Board recently approved the use of golf carts throughout the Village. A permit is required and available for \$25/yr. at the Village Office. Golf carts not issued a permit are subject to a citation.

Park & Lake Information:

- When attendants are on duty, parking at the Lakeview Park is \$5 per vehicle, unless you provide a driver’s license, auto registration, or utility bill showing an address within village boundaries.
- All boats (including lakefront property owners) are subject to launch fees.
- **Lakefront owners wanting to launch on the weekend please be aware: All launches are subject to the 12 boat limit on the lake.**
- **Launch fees are per watercraft not trailer.**

BEACH REGULATIONS:

- Grilling, barbecuing or otherwise cooking food with gas, wood, charcoal, or any other heating source is prohibited on the beach.
- Smoking of all kinds, including but not limited to: cigarettes, electronic cigarettes, vapor cigarettes, and all other tobacco products are prohibited on the beach.
- Dogs are not allowed on the beach or in the swim area.



Slow, no wake speed enforced

7 pm to 10 am everyday
(Sunset to 10 am if sunset is before 7 pm)

Boats: Within 100 ft. of any shoreline, dock, raft, pier, watercraft or restricted area.

Watercraft: Within 200 ft. of any shoreline, dock, raft, pier, watercraft or restricted area.

For the entire length of the Launching channel at Lakeview Park.

Here are a few basic guidelines to keep in mind based on the U.S. Flag Code:

- ◆ Always make sure the flag never touches the ground or anything below it.
- ◆ Do not display the American Flag in inclement weather, unless it’s an all weather flag.
- ◆ If you want to fly the flag after sunset, keep it well lit.
- ◆ When displayed either horizontally or vertically against a wall, the Union (blue section) should be uppermost and to the flag’s own right, that is, to the observer’s left. When displayed in a window, the flag should be displayed in the same way, with the Union to the left of the observer’s view.
- ◆ No other flag or pennant should be placed above, or, if on the same level, to the right of the American flag.

There is a drop box at the parking lot entrance to the Village Hall for proper disposal.

3rd Quarter Utility Billing:

Utility Bills will look a bit different starting this September. The Village will be moving to postcards. Newsletters will no longer be sent out. Instead, newsletters can be emailed, found on the website, picked up in the office, or read at the post office, library, or at the Village Hall.

VILLAGE REMINDERS:

- * The brush pile will be closed July 18th-26th.
- * Yard Maintenance: All lawns in the Village must be maintained at a height no greater than 6 inches. Vacant lots must also be kept cut to prevent weeds from spreading to neighboring properties. **Please remember lawn cutting debris is not to be blown onto the street or sidewalks per Village ordinance.**
- * Building permits are required for new home construction, roofing projects, siding, and certain remodeling projects. If you have questions on whether or not you need a permit, please feel free to call the Village office.
