**UPDATES FOR AUGUST-
SEPTEMBER:**

FEE SCHEDULE UPDATES - At the August 7th meeting the village updated their fee schedule to include the following:

- Split line item “Smoking/Grilling on the beach (prohibited)” into two separate lines
 - * Grilling on the beach (prohibited) \$100 fine
 - * Smoking on the beach (prohibited) \$100 fine

PARKING ATTENDANT - After September 4th there will no longer be a park attendant at Bob McDermott Lakeview Park. Parking passes will be self serve and available by the boat launch.

PUBLIC FIRE PROTECTION BACKBILLING - Reminder that this payment is due November 1, 2023. On May 1, 2023 an invoice was issued to all utility users whom had accounts during the timeframe of July 10, 2022 through December 14, 2022. If you are unsure of if you paid your invoice, please call village hall and we can let you know if there is still a balance due.

BERTRAM UPDATE - Representatives from Bertram and 5 Star will be going from property to property to receive authorization for a “Right of Entry Agreement” or a “Declining Waiver”. The current grant includes all home to be installed up to the home for free. This is just installation of the fiber cable to the home. This does not mean you would need to sign up for service at this time. For additional questions please contact Bertram at 920-351-1023.

ROAD CLOSURES - There are multiple events happening throughout the village in the next coming month which will result in road closures.

- ⇒ Fall Color Run on Saturday, September 23rd at 5:30 pm will be ran on several streets within the village. These closures will be temporary as the event will be concluded after about 2 hours.
- ⇒ Private event on Saturday, September 23rd at 2 pm and going until 8 am the next day, Sunday the 24th. Carroll St from 1st to 2nd St.
- ⇒ Fall Family Fun on Saturday, September 30th, all day. Carroll St from 1st to 4th St, 2nd St from Allen to Butler St.
