UPDATES FOR NOVEMBER- DECEMBER:

FREE MULCH - After the brush pile has been closed for the year the pile is chipped up. The result is a pile of mulch. Please contact DPW if you are interested in picking up some of the mulch.

ILLEGAL ANIMALS - The only allowable animals within the village are licensed dogs and cats. Unless your property is zoned agricultural, then you are permitted to have livestock. At this months meeting the village approved fining property owners who violate this ordinance Chapter 4.

DOGS IN THE PARK - Dogs are now allowed on the beach, in the swim area, and anywhere else in the water besides the boat launch area. Boaters are allowed to have a dog in the boat launch area, on a leash to get to and from their boats, but not in the water for safety reasons.

TREATMENT PLANT REPAIRS - At the November 13th meeting the board approved repairs to the Wastewater Treatment Plant to include: Resealing field seams and roof flashings, replacement of west side upper roof assembly, chemical room exhaust fan, and main room exhaust fan. Repairs are to be completed before the end of 2023 to help with excess condensation within the plant.

Winter is coming soon, when do parking restrictions occur?

Winter parking does not go into effect until the plow hits the roads for the first time. Currently as of the time of this publishing this has not happened and the parking restrictions are not in effect.

An alert will be sent out to all residents when the restrictions do go into place. If you believe you are not signed up for the alert system, please contact village hall to ensure your contact information is up to date.

These restrictions are no parking on village streets from 2:45 am - 7 am. You may not park overnight on the street even if there is no snow.

These restrictions are put into place to ensure if and when it snows the DPW crew is able to clear the roads in a more timely manner.

Tax Bills The 2023 tax bills will be sent out in late November/early December. These mailings come directly from Sheboygan County. 1st installment is due January 31st. Method of payment can be at village hall, through the mail, or the drop box outside village hall

d) *Leaf burning.* Leaf burning is allowed in the village in the yard of the residence in which the leaves fall.

It is not legal to burn leaves in the street, if you have any questions, please feel free to reach out.
