- Remove tripping hazards to keep your home safe for visiting trick-or-treaters.
 Sweep wet leaves from sidewalks and steps to prevent anyone from slipping on them.
- * Restrain pets so they do not jump on or bite a trick-or-treater.
- # Make things spooky, but not too spooky, check outdoor lights and replace burned-out bulbs.



- * Trick or Treat with friends & never alone
- # Carry a flashlight & cellphone, just in case you need them and glow sticks are a great idea to be visible in the dark or something that is reflective to headlights
- # Always walk on the sidewalks, but if they're not any walk against traffic so you can see cars approaching you
- * Avoid wearing masks that obstruct your vision & dress for the weather
