This is to give you notice that the Random Lake Municipal Water Dept will file an application on December 6, 2013, with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC), for authority to increase water rates. Rates for general service will increase 3 percent. The increase is necessary to reduce the existing deficiency in present rates. The request is being made under Wis. Stat. 196.193.
